

SERVICES SET TOMORROW FOR ELIZABETH KIDD

Services for Mrs. Elizabeth Ayres Kidd, 76, musician, composer, and collector of rare musical instruments, will be held at 1:30 p. m. tomorrow in the chapel at 1100 Greenleaf av., Wilmette. Mrs. Kidd, who lived in Glenview until two years ago, died Wednesday in British West Indies.

Mrs. Kidd had collected more than 300 folk instruments from foreign countries. She received piano training at the University of Chicago, and later studied music at various universities in Europe.

Survivors include her husband, Albert E. Jr.; a daughter, Mrs. Geraldine Bardaras; two sons, Harlan and Dr. David E. Kidd; nine grandchildren; and a great-grandchild.
